Seasonal Tips

1. Water

Deep water your trees and shrubs prior to freezing



5. Plant

Plant trees with a "focus on bark texture / colour" to provide winter interest



6. Winter Interest

Include plants with berries to provide winter interest and food for overwintering birds



2. Fertilize

Fertilize your lawn prior to the first freeze



3. Mow

Do a final mow of your lawn to prevent thatching in spring



4. Mulching

Protect roots by mulching to provide insulation and nutrients



8. Avoid Salt

Minimize salt use on driveways and sidewalk



7. Strategize

Consider strategically planted evergreens to create highlights within the landscape
