Movala
3340 Lakeshore is a mixed-use development, in a prime location within Pandosy Village, adjacent to Gyro Beach, Kelowna. CTQ designed the urban realm and podium, with construction underway.

UBCO ICI
This project involves developing a key site at UBCO Campus's southern entrance, emphasizing urban design, indigenous elements, and sustainability. Our work includes a concept booklet, master plan, and 3D visuals to present our vision, featuring passive and active areas linked by boardwalks and stormwater swales, all showcasing regional materials. Construction documents and construction underway.

Spirit Park
Spirit Park in Naramata, BC, is set for a redesign to enhance public spaces, amenities, and stormwater retention. Bordered by roads and sports courts, with grade differences causing runoff, the plan aims to integrate current amenities while expanding public use and managing stormwater with natural landscaping solutions.



Spring Seasonal Tips

1. Clean-Up
Clear debris such as branches, leaves, annual plants from last year.

2. Prune
Start with anything that had been broken or damaged. Do not prune early flowering shrubs and those that bloom

3. Test / Feed your Soil
After testing, ask your local garden centre about specific products you'll need

4. Plant containers and borders
Some cool weather loving plants won't mind if you plant them early.

5. Mulch
Refresh the beds with fresh organic mulch as necessary to maintain optimal moisture levels and warmth, nurturing the emerging spring growth



Engineering



Harrison Hot Springs Screw Pump Flood Control
Harrison Hot Springs experienced severe floods, leading to a provincial agreement to fund dyke construction for protection. The project, facilitated by CTQ, involved replacing an existing pump to enhance flood defense and meet environmental laws, with funding from Provincial and Federal programs. During the design, CTQ prioritized environmental considerations, even consulting fish biologists to select a "fish-friendly" Canary Yellow color for the pump, reflecting their commitment to eco-conscious solutions.




Krischner Mountain
CTQ undertook a development project to revamp a significant part of the property, resulting in a new Area Structure Plan/OCP amendment aligning with the City's vision. The project includes around 700 mixed-density residential units, parks, open spaces, and potential retail areas, spread over 150 acres near Kirschner Mountain, a prime development spot in Kelowna.


