What's New

Seasonal Tips

- 1. Prune**
Trim dead or damaged branches from trees and shrubs while the structure is clearly visible.
- 2. Protect**
Apply a layer of mulch around trees, plants and shrubs to provide insulation and nutrients.
- 3. Wrap-Up**
Cover vulnerable plants with burlap or other protective coverings to shield them in winter.
- 4. Aerate**
Aerate the lawn before the first frost to improve drainage and allow nutrients to penetrate it.
- 5. De-Ice**
Use pet-friendly de-icers when removing snow, and avoid using salt, which can cause damage.
- 6. Inspect**
Check patios, walkways and retaining walls for cracks vulnerable to freezing and thawing.
- 7. Drain**
Drain hoses, fountains and irrigation systems to prevent freezing and any potential damage.
- 8. Prepare**
Browse online, design new garden layouts and identify projects you want to tackle in spring.

Landscape Architecture

Young Street, Truro, Nova Scotia

Young Street is a residential development comprising of a mix of single and stacked townhouse units, and 4 storey apartment buildings. The client is focused on creating a sustainable and net zero development, which enables the master planning of the site to focus on ways to enhance the natural environment within the project site and assist with the ultimate goal of creating a unique development for the region.

The foundational principle of the landscape approach is that the development should perform as an integrated component of the local ecosystem. The central water feature is treated not as a decorative element but as a dynamic hydrological and biological system, its health paramount to the project's overall ecological function. Mature forest stands are carefully retained, their value measured in the immediate habitat complexity, carbon sequestration, wind buffering, and deep-rooted sense of authenticity they provide. Siting and programming are deliberately orchestrated to frame views from multi-story units and provide ground-level dwellings with direct, seamless access to naturalized parks and meadow spaces. Circulation is designed for legibility and immersion, utilizing a network of trails and boardwalks that minimize grading and soil compaction, allowing residents to engage with the landscape without damaging its delicate components.





Nicola Valley Institute of Technology Residence and Daycare Upgrades

The Nicola Valley Institute of Technology (NVIT) Residence and Daycare Upgrades project is currently under construction, with completion of the new townhouses and two-storey daycare facility scheduled for early spring. The development includes two residential 6-plex buildings, a daycare, internal loop road, parking areas, playgrounds, and supporting civil infrastructure designed to accommodate both current needs and future campus expansion.

CTQ Consultants Ltd. is providing full civil engineering services from initial design through construction and post-construction, including servicing design, grading, internal roadway layout, and coordination with the City of Merritt. The project is being delivered by a strong and collaborative consultant and construction team, including Sahuri (Architect), Reinbold (Mechanical), Falcon (Structural), ARN (Builder), and KLL Construction (Civil Contractor).


